



REGULATIONS OF SCHOOL TRANSPORT

- A student using the school bus is expected to be at the bus stop at least five minutes before the scheduled arrival of the bus. If school bus is missed due to the student's delay, the conveyance for the day has to be arranged by the parent concerned.
- The student has to be on the correct side of the arriving bus.
- Students must keep all parts of their body inside the bus at all times.
- They should not put their hands out even for waving.
- No object should be thrown inside or outside the bus.
- The consumption of edibles and drinks is considered in the bus but without spilling and disturbing others.
- Unruly behaviour like shrieking and shouting is strictly prohibited.
- The driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason.
- The drivers are authorised to stop buses only at designated stops. The list of stops is prepared keeping in view the convenience and safety of all bus commuters and is subject to change.
